The restaurant will serve authentic Italian food including Mushroom Cannelloni with fontina cheese and truffle, Puntarelle salad with Straciatella cheese and anchovy dressing, Pizza Stracchino with stracchino cheese, rucola, prosciutto ham and truffle. *The Beefbar*, also created by Riccardo Giraudi, uses top quality ingredients sourced from highly distinguished providers offering the finest cuts of Black Angus Prime, Wagyu WX and Kobe beef alongside fresh grilled fish, ceviche and carpaccio. New additions to the menu include tartiflette with beef prosciutto, gratin dauphinois and a delicious beef stew.

New Spa Package

The hotel's indoor and outdoor pool, six massage treatment rooms with specialist treatments from Tata Harper and a sauna area offer guests a deeply relaxing experience after a day of skiing. The pool areas, divided by a bay window create a stunning, trompe-l'oeil effect with views of the striking vista outdoors. State-of-the-art fitness equipment, boxing facilities and a dedicated space for Pilates and yoga all offer panoramic views across the peaks.
