As soon as you arrive, the garden of Lou Pinet welcomes you like a dream. Created by the landscape architect Jean Mus, an artist and craftsman from Grasse, the aromatic vegetable garden is surrounded by the umbrella pines. A path of old and patinated flagstones with scents of pine, lavender, oranges, and lemon trees guides guests to the rooms and suites.

## A decoration inspired by local culture

Designed as a private home, Lou Pinet is a refuge where you can gather with family or friends for a holiday getaway. The hotel is inspired by the work of artists who appreciate the beauty of the South of France, and the love of colour, starting with Matisse, Calder, and Picasso. Natural light and rounded shapes intertwine in homage to the style of the 60s and 70s, and are incorporated into furniture elements such as benches and lighting fixtures. Antique trinkets, vintage plates hanging on the wall, sculptures... Each piece has been carefully selected, showcasing the region's artisanal heritage, from the pottery of Vallauris to the glassworks of Biot. Designed by Charles Zana, an interior architect, and designer, this decor is inspired by the cultural richness of Saint Tropez and its local artists, offering Lou Pinet a singular identity.

The warm light of the South penetrates the different spaces of this residence, revealing the 34 rooms and suites that compose it.
